The ideal candidate will possess the following key competencies, record of experience and academic preparation:

- College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) unrestricted license that allows the physician to fulfil the requirements of this position.
- Demonstrate commitment to continued professional and personal growth and development through Continuing Education Programs and Self Directed Learning opportunities.
- For internationally trained Physicians, the hospital may provide support in attaining a CPSO licence under their existing guidelines and provide the necessary mentorship requirements in exchange for a 3.0/1.0 ratio. (3 years of service for 1 year of mentorship). We cannot provide immigration services/assistance at this time.
